Y3/4 Educational Visit to Creswell Crag

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our topic in the Spring term 'Stone Age', we have arranged an educational visit to Creswell Crag in Derbyshire. This amazing limestone gorge was once home to Ice Age animals and Stone Age hunters. During the visit, the children will explore one of the caves in Creswell Crag to hear stories of survival in the Stone Age. They will experience what it took to survive as a Stone Age person and start to understand what art meant to the very first artists by becoming a prehistoric painter.

The trip will take place on **Friday 7th February 2025. The coaches will leave at 9:00am. All children must be in school on time** to be registered by their class teacher. The coach will leave Creswell at 2:30pm and we should be back at school between **3:30 and 3:45pm**, depending on traffic. Children should come to school wearing school uniform t-shirt and jumper with warm trousers and outdoor footwear for the outdoor activities.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with them and a water bottle. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and would like to order a packed lunch, then please notify the school office.

The **cost of the trip is £24** which includes the coach fare and three activities during the day: Stone Age Cave Story, Survival Skills workshop and Art of the Ancients workshop.

Please make payment and give consent for your child to attend via your ParentPay account by Thursday 31st January 2025.
